



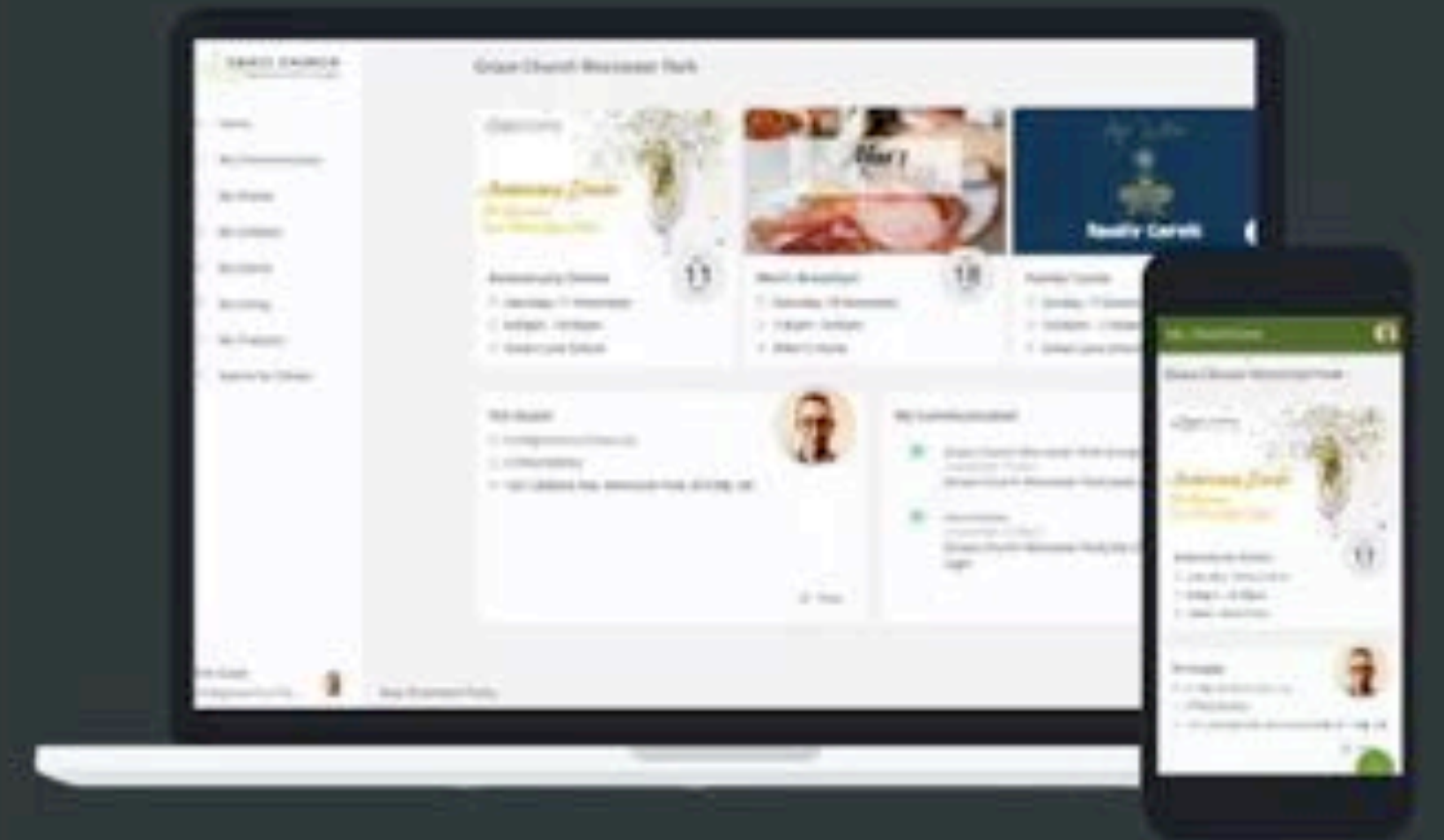

Commissioning of Bob Mallet as a Grace Church Elder



Introduction

Bob, in being called to be an elder in God's church, you are to proclaim God's gospel and teach his Word, to shepherd God's flock, steward his household and to prepare God's people for works of service that the body of Christ here at Grace Church may be built up in maturity attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

The Bible teaches in Titus 1:6-9 that:



Titus 1:6-9

6 An elder must be blameless, the husband of but one wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient. 7 Since an overseer is entrusted with God's work, he must be blameless—not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to drunkenness, not violent, not pursuing dishonest gain. 8 Rather he must be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined. 9 He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.

Having examined Bob to ensure that he is suited by his knowledge of Scripture and godliness of life to exercise ministry as an elder, we commend him for commissioning today to this ministry.



Elder: Bob, are you persuaded and will you consistently teach that salvation comes through faith alone, in Christ alone, by grace alone? And will you commit to teach God's gospel with care, with faithfulness, with boldness, and above all, with love?

Bob: By God's grace, I will.



Elder: Bob, will you be ready and careful to refute all teaching that is contrary to the Bible, both publicly and privately, and in doing so support the godly exercise of discipline in this church?

Bob: By God's grace, I will.



Elder: Bob, remembering that the church is Christ's bride, body and temple, will you commit to shepherd this flock and to prepare us for works of service so that we might be built up in faith, love and hope, and reach out with the good news of the gospel to those around us?

Bob: By God's grace, I will.



Elder: Bob, will you commit to pray continually, seeking the power of the Holy Spirit to equip you for this work? And will you read God's Word daily so that you may grow in faith and godliness, being an example to your family, the church and the wider community of Worcester Park?

Bob: By God's grace, I will.



Elder: Bob, will you respectfully and gladly submit yourself to those who are over you, willingly accepting their godly counsel and support them in their ministry?

Bob: By God's grace, I will.



Elder: And now a commitment for us all to make as a church family.

Will you, the church family of Grace Church, support Bob in his ministry, pray for him and submit to his leadership as an elder in this church?

Church family: By God's grace, we will.



Elder: So, Bob, we commission you for your ministry as an elder of Grace Church, Worcester Park. We present you with this Bible containing the inspired word of God, which is living and active and sharper than any double-edged sword. We give you this charge: Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction...keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.



All: Merciful Father, grant Bob, grace to perform his ministry according to your Holy Word and our church grace to receive it and amend our lives accordingly. To your glory and the increase of your kingdom, through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.



Concluding prayer:

Father God, we pray that your Holy Spirit will fill Bob, with the truth of your Word and the holiness of your Son that he may faithfully serve you to the glory of your name and for the building up of your church into the fullness of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God now and forever. Amen.

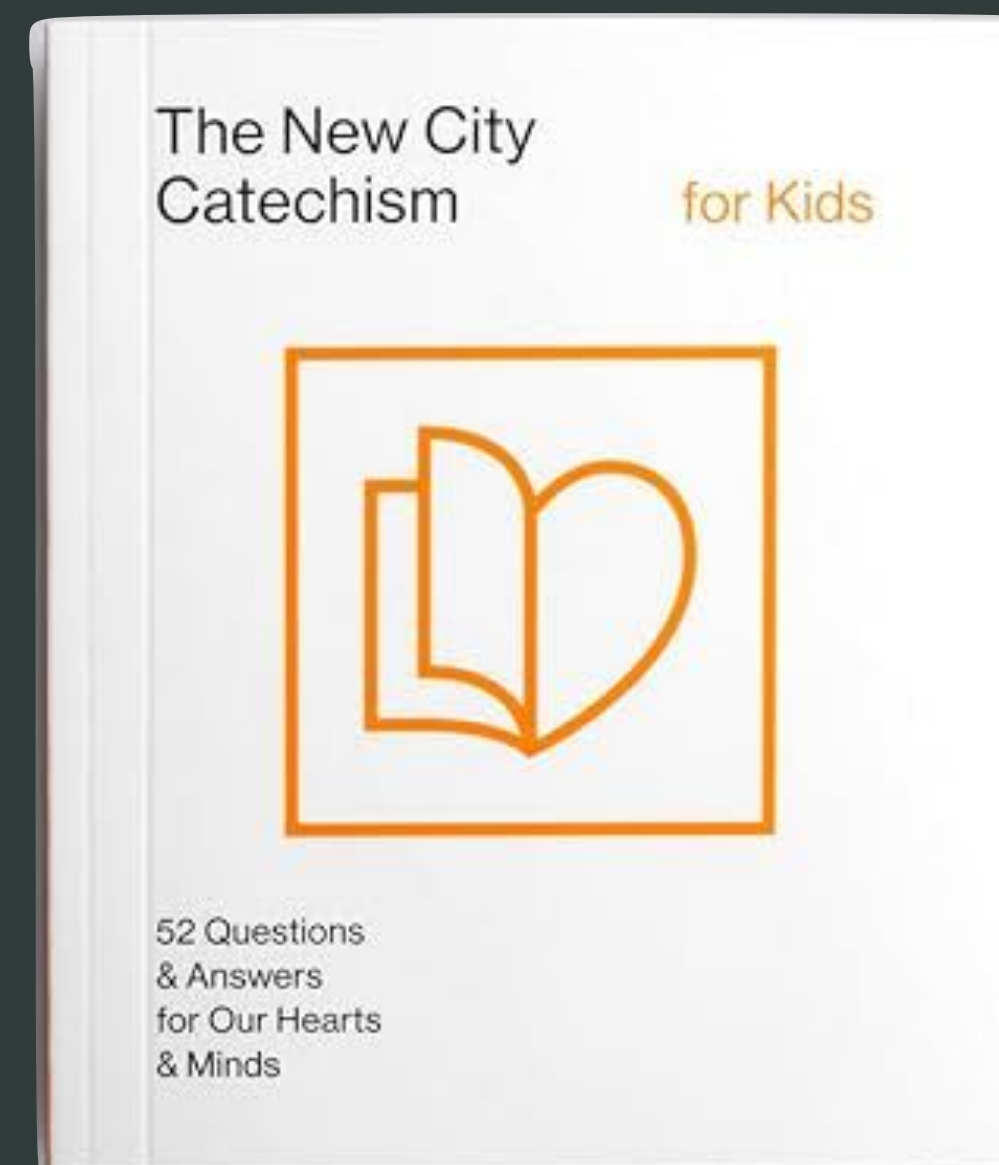

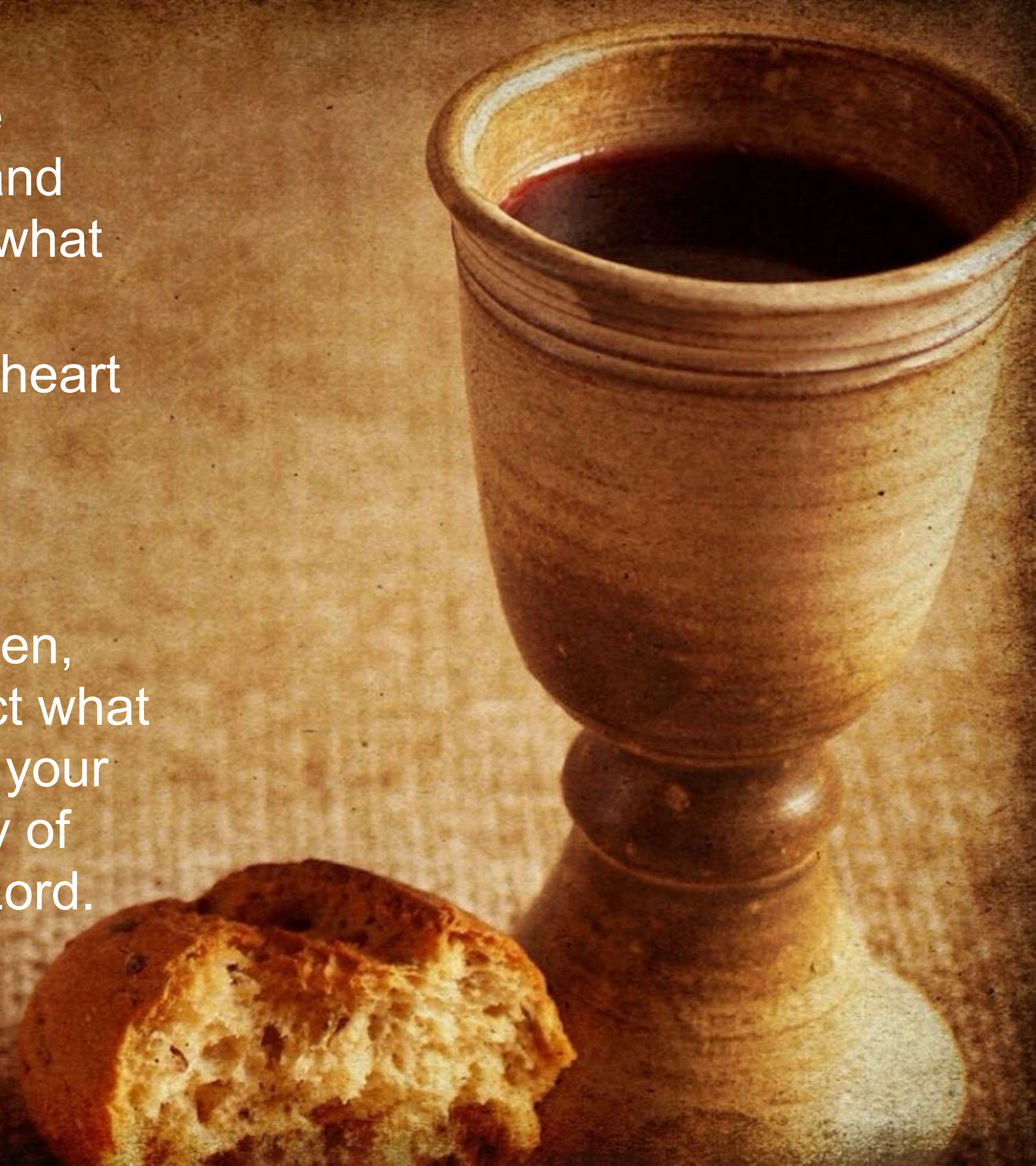
Merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.

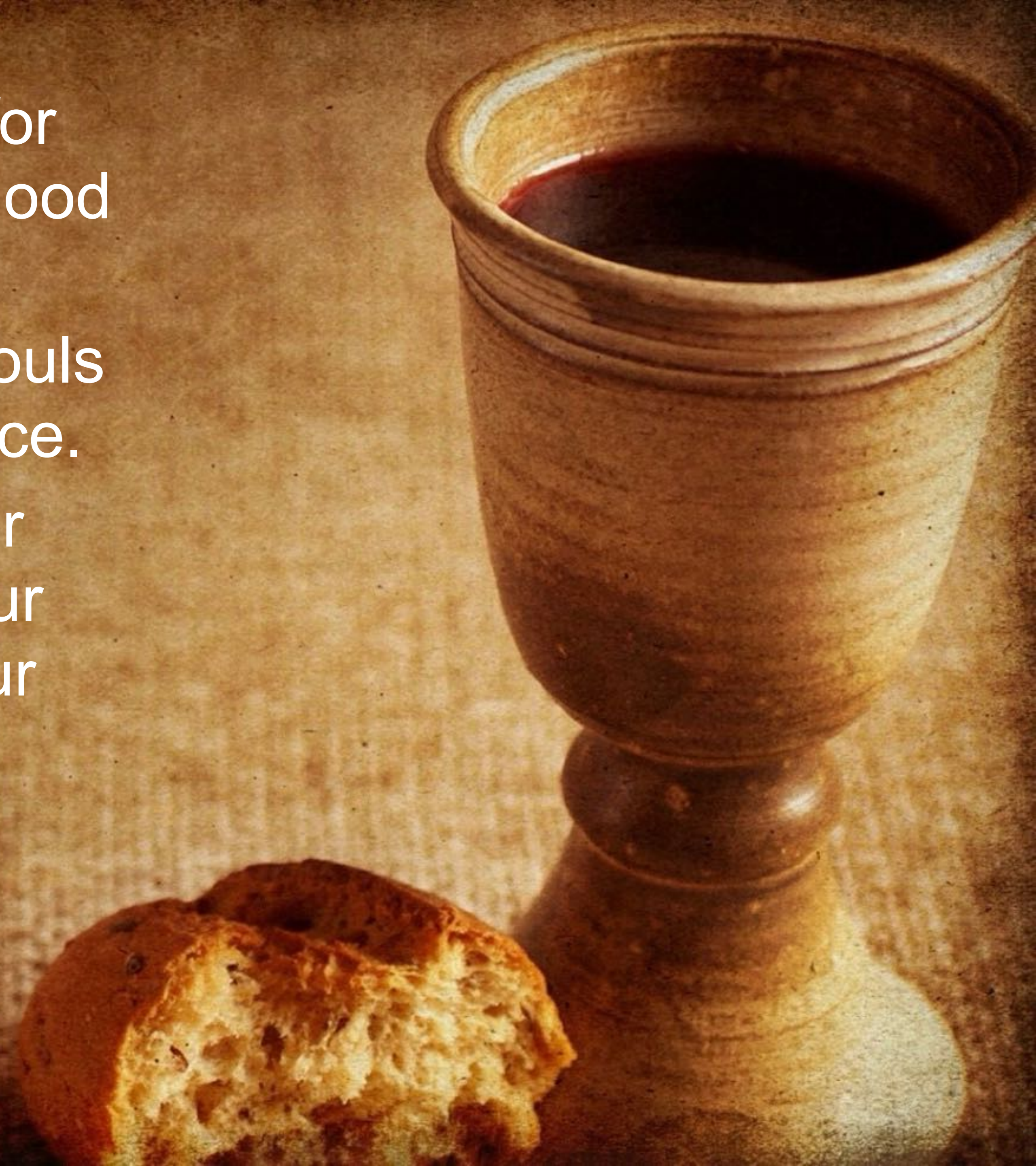




Our Father God, we thank you for feeding us with the body and blood of your Son Jesus Christ.
