


The Bible teaches in Titus 1:6-9 that:

Elder: Bob, remembering that the church is Christ's bride, body and temple, will you commit to shepherd this flock and to prepare us for works of service so that we might be built up in faith, love and hope, and reach out with the good news of the gospel to those around us?





















Elder: Bob, will you commit to pray continually, seeking the power of the Holy Spirit to equip you for this work? And will you read God's Word daily so that you may grow in faith and godliness, being an example to your family, the church and the wider community of Worcester Park?





















Elder: Bob, will you respectfully and gladly submit yourself to those who are over you, willingly accepting their godly counsel and support them in their ministry?























Will you, the church family of Grace Church, support Bob in his ministry, pray for him and submit to his leadership as an elder in this church?

Church family: By God's grace, we will.





















Elder: So, Bob, we commission you for your ministry as an elder of Grace Church, Worcester Park. We present you with this Bible containing the inspired word of God, which is living and active and sharper than any double-edged sword. We give you this charge: Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage with great patience and careful instruction...keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.












Question 16 What is sin?




We have not loved you with our whole heart and mind and strength.
