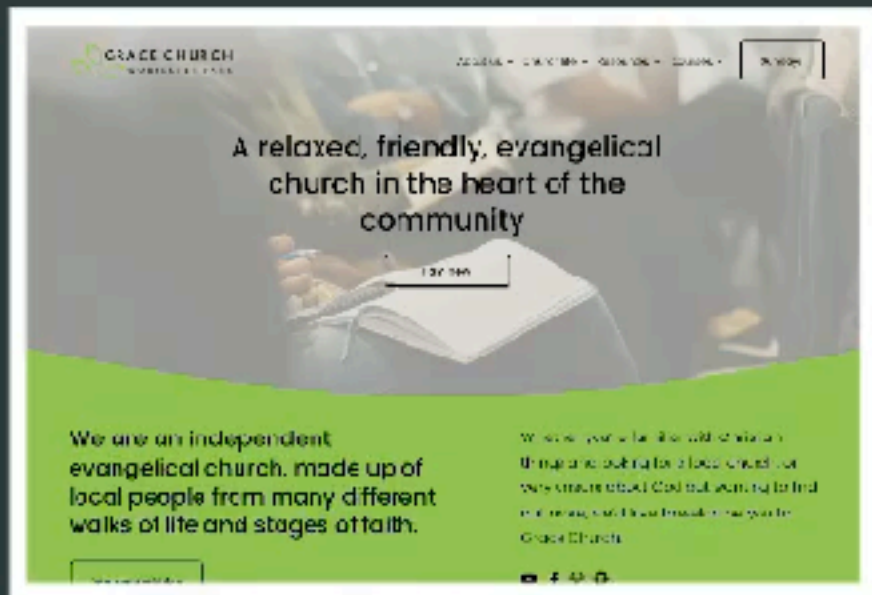




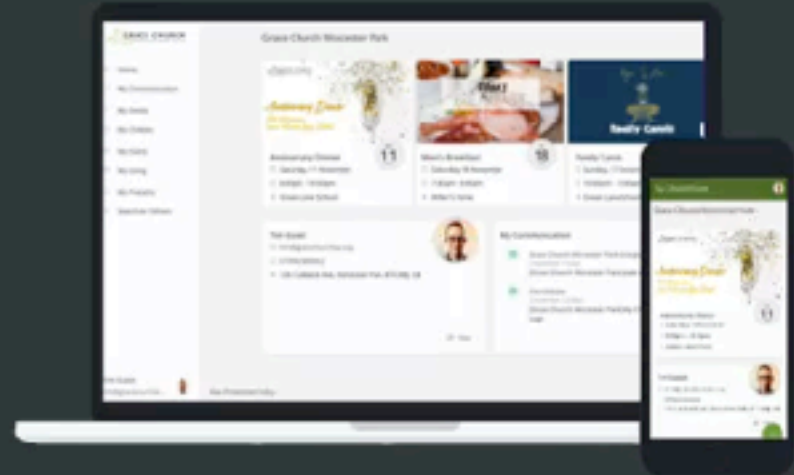

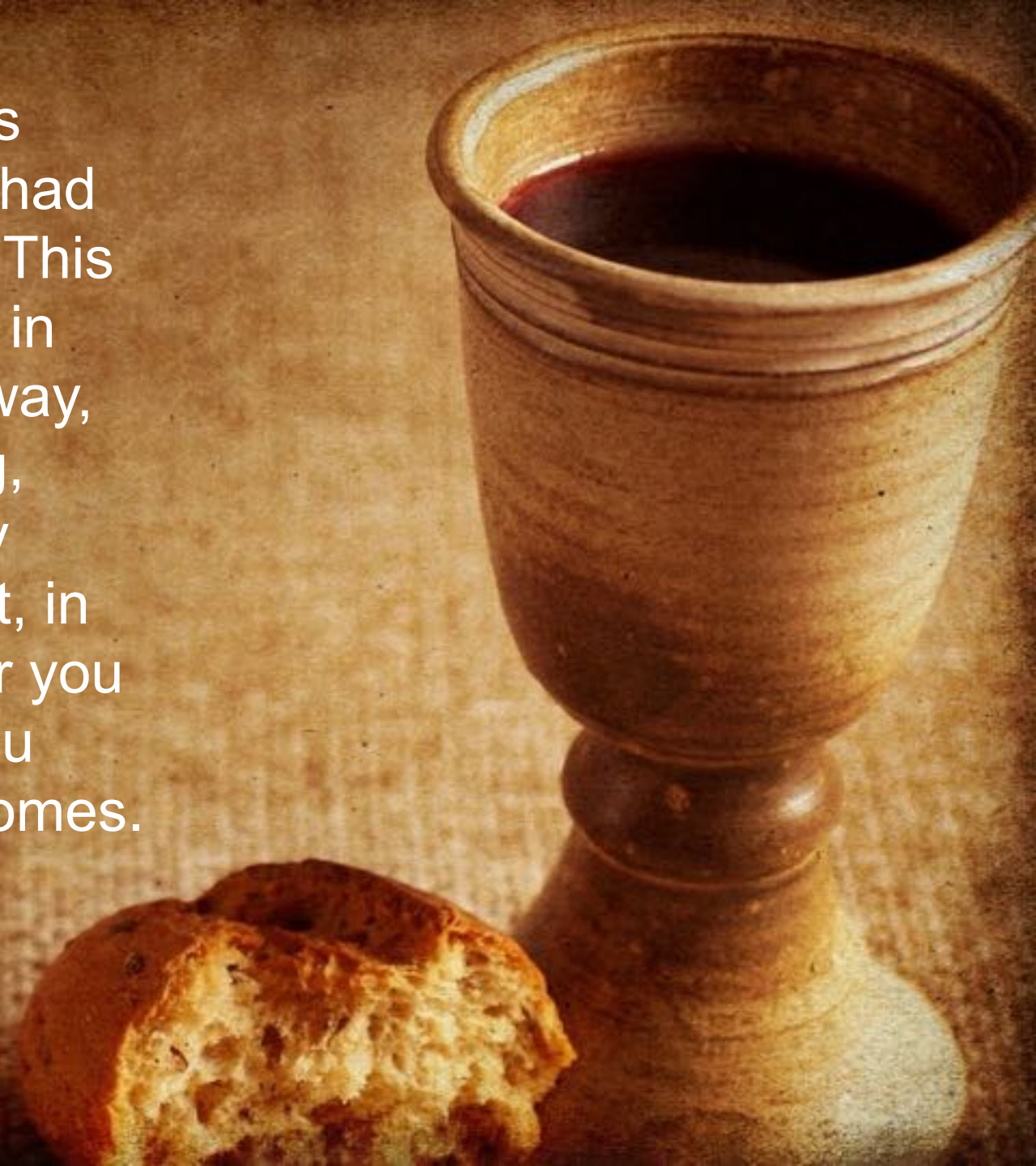

1 Corinthians 11:23-26

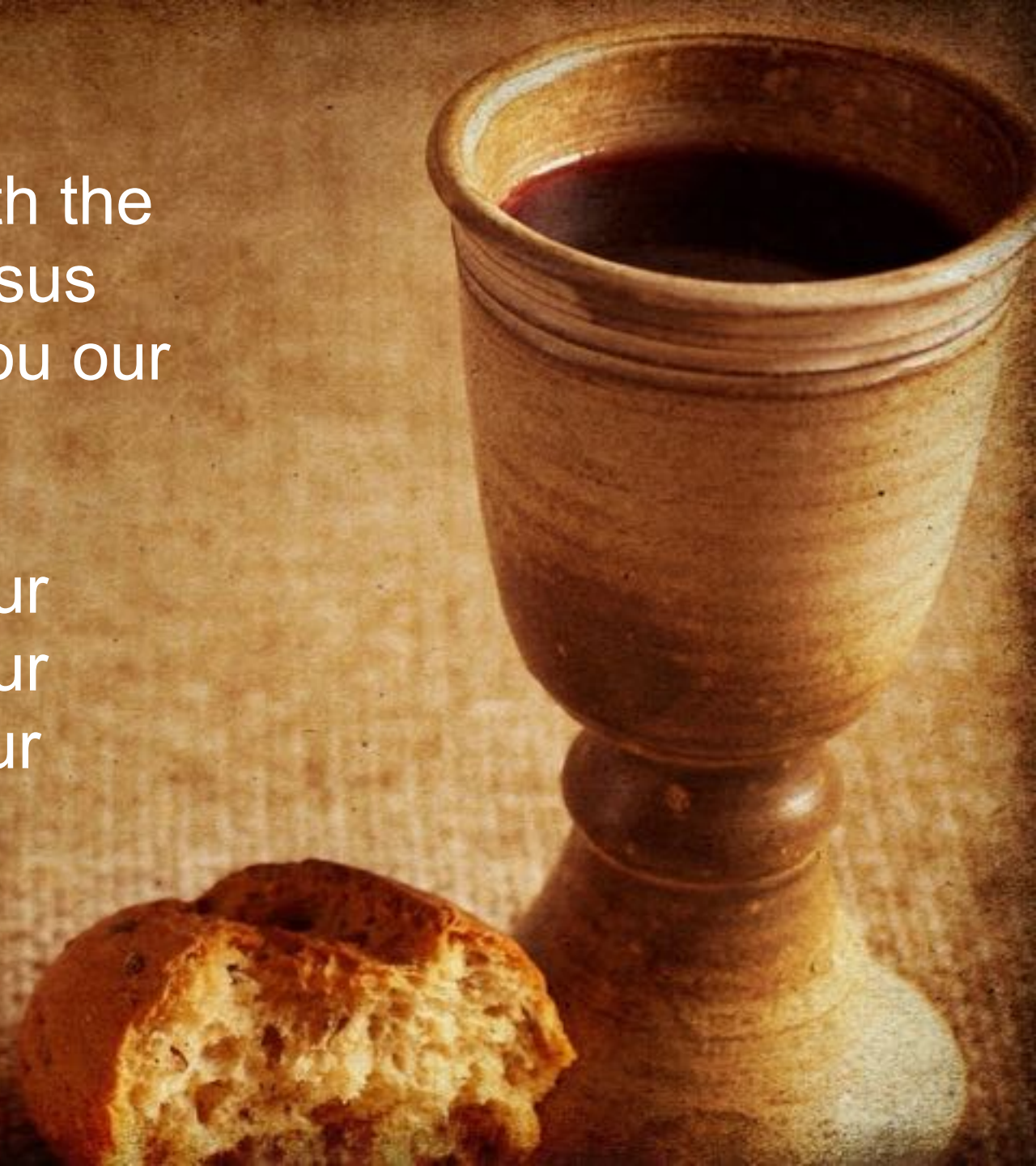




Our Father God,

1 Pe 2:21–25.

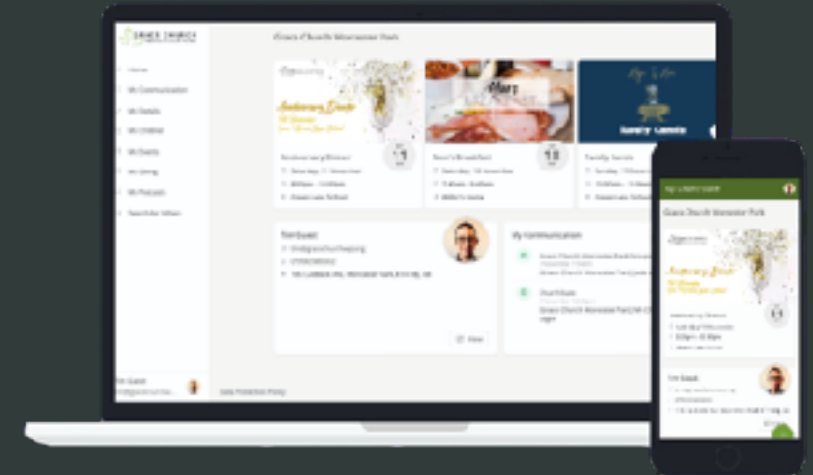
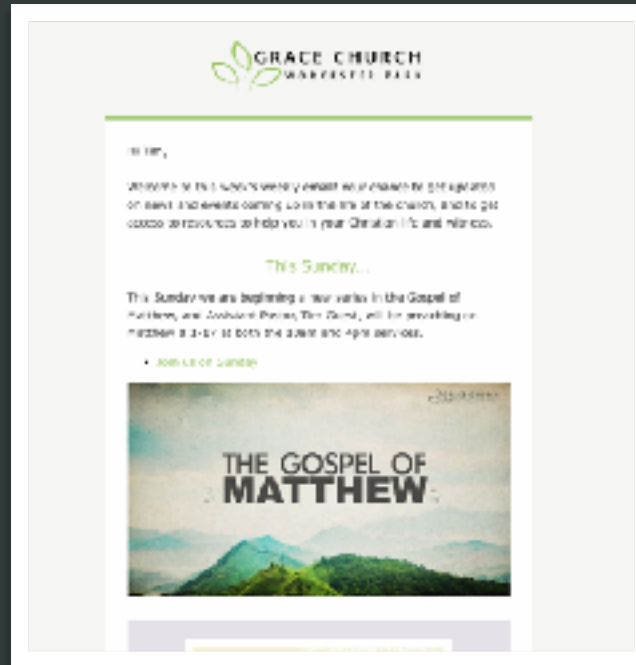

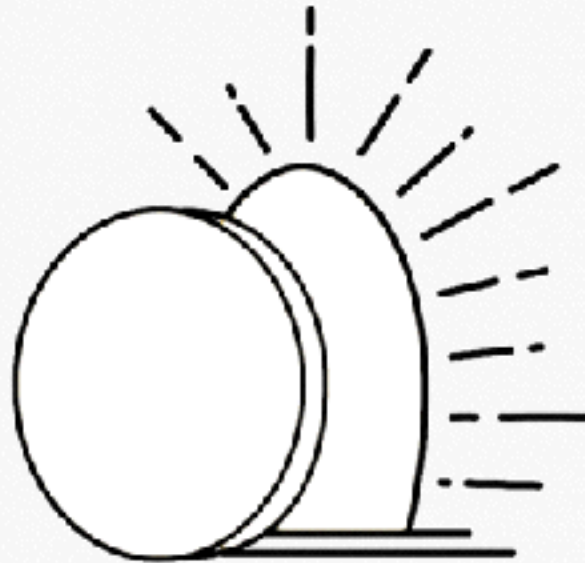
